Grade AMB

Grade AMB offers a heavy duty finish. Highly resistant to dirt, liquids, sunlight and wear and tear. This leather is easy to keep clean, and is excellent for families with children and pets.

Grade EXP

These are top grain leathers finished with fine pigments which leave a smooth and silky finish. Many of these leathers are distressed by buffing, sanding, or two tone finishes. The highly protected leather in this series is easy to keep clean and is excellent for families with children.

Grade COR

This is top grain leather with slightly more luxury than the EXP series. Natural scars and markings are more evident. COR leather is very soft and is aimed towards clients who want a touch of luxury without the ANI cost

Grade ANI

Grade ANI are full top grain leather. Aniline dyed and slightly pigmented, these leathers are super soft to the hand. Natural marking are very pronounced and add to the leather's inherent beauty. Over time these leathers will work a well worn patina. This grade is perfect for clients who insist on the best and most natural leathers with a slight protective coat.
